Varkari Diwas

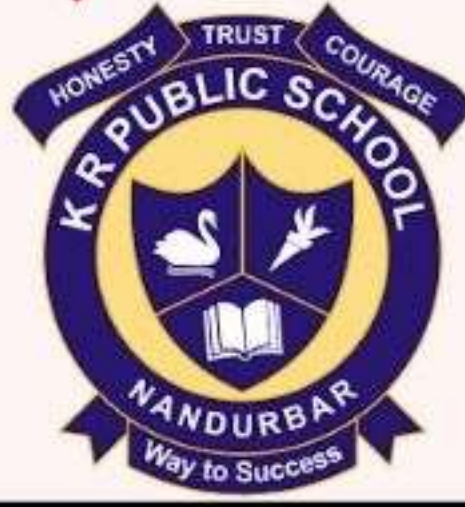

School Election



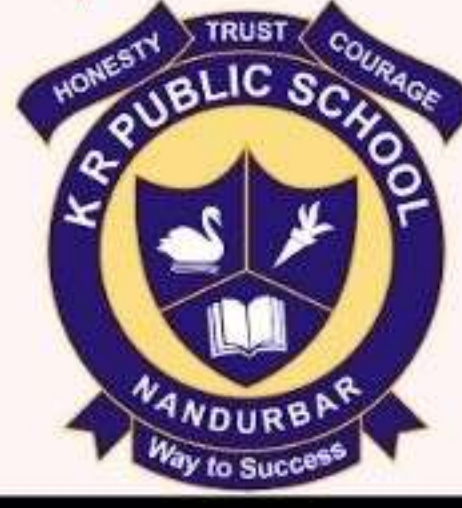

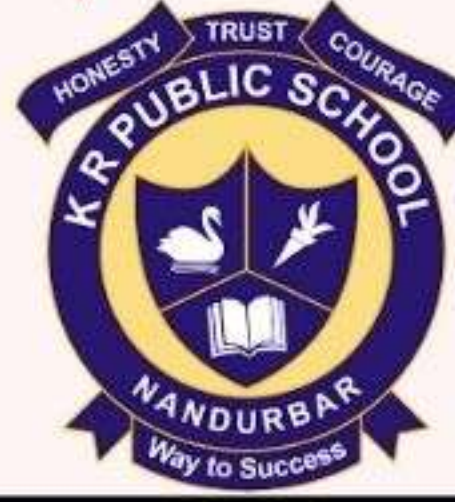
