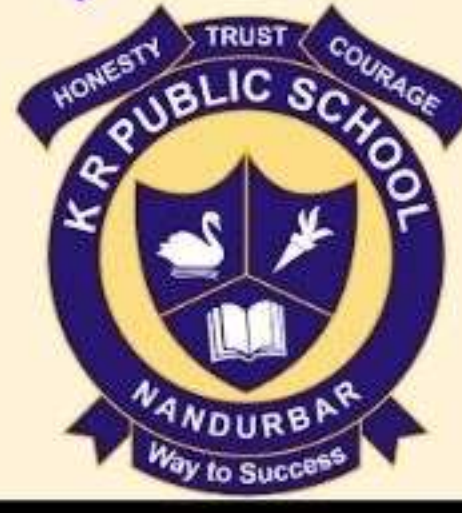

Farm Animals Showcase Activity



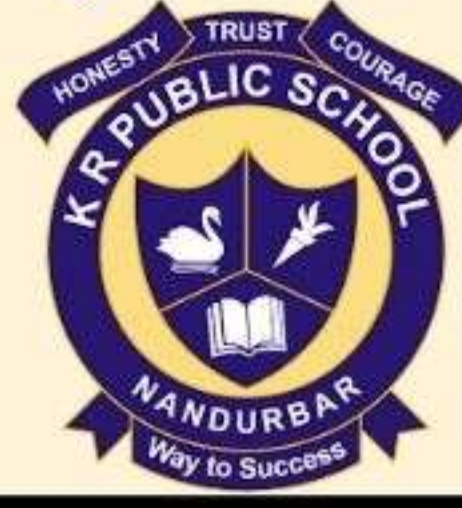
