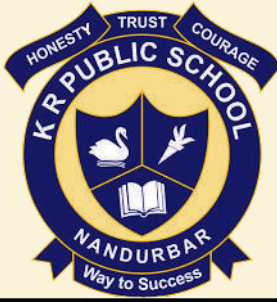
To foster a sense of belonging and healthy competition, the students were divided into Four Houses:

Report on tableau competition organised on Gandhi Jayanti



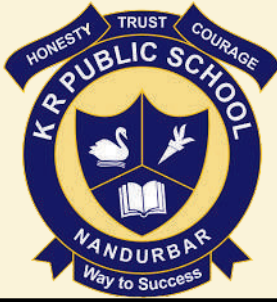

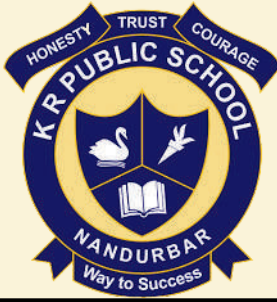
School reopening after Diwali: a day of fun and frolic !
