Hindi diwas celebration

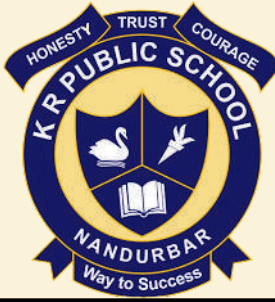

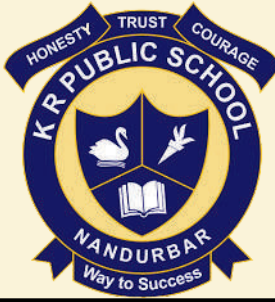
PTA Meetings

Nukkad natak

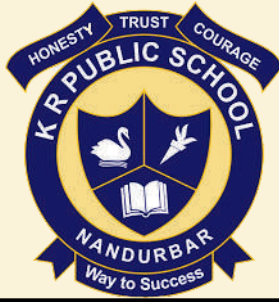

Tata Building India-essay competition



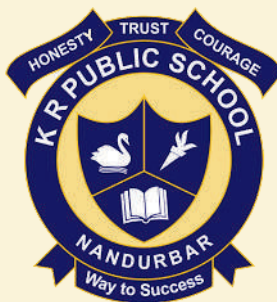

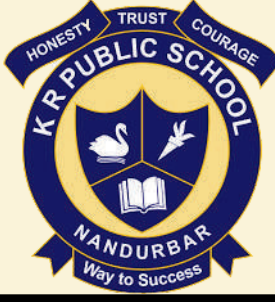

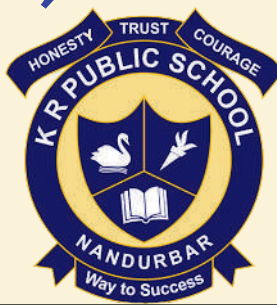
